H.R.H. DUCHESS OF KENT

Her Royal Highness, Duchess of Kent, was the mother of the future Queen Victoria.

It is a near certainty that the young Victoria used this key to access the "East Garden Gate," presumably the garden at Kensington Palace where she was born in 1819. Victoria ascended the throne in 1837 and ruled Great Britain until her death in 1901.
