

THE HONOURABLE JOHN ST. JOHN

Chesterfield Gate is an entrance to Greenwich Park in London.

The park was the first of the Royal Parks to be enclosed (in 1433), and houses the Royal Observatory as well as other notable buildings. This key belonged to the Honourable John St. John, which allowed him personal access to the then-gated park.

St. John was born in 1725 and died in 1767, and inherited the title of Baron St. John upon the death of his father in 1757. This key would date to about 1750.
