X-10 Forced-Relock Operating Instructions

Note:

These instructions assume the X-10 is stuck in the unlocked condition, preventing the user from dialing clockwise. All dialing will be done to the left only.

- 1. Power the lock by dialing counter-clockwise past "99" ten times. This will take a considerable effort, so care must be taken when following the rest of this process to avoid this step again.
- 2. The lock will prompt with "<-rL", this is the indication that the lock has entered the relock mode.
- 3. Dial left several turns and the lock will display numbers with a left arrow.
- 4. Dial the first number of any valid combination, when the number is reached, stop dialing. If the target number is dialed past, continue dialing left until the displayed numbers "come back around" to the target number.
- 5. After about two seconds, the lock will again display the "<-rL" prompt. This indicates that it has registered the displayed number.
- 6. Repeat steps 3 5 for the second and third numbers of the combination.
- 7. After three numbers have been registered, the lock will respond with either a lightning bolt (if the combination is not valid) or another "<-rL" prompt (if the combination is valid). Dialing an incorrect combination counts as an unsuccessful open attempt, and may result in a penalty.
- 8. Dial left again and the lock will operate the motor to relock, then shut down.
